Suni Muslims celebrate the day that Nuh (Noah) left the arc and the day that Musa (Moses) was saved from the Egyptians by Allah. Shi'ite's mark the martyrdom of Hussein.  • 21 <sup>st</sup> Youle - Pagan festival that marks the winter solstice when the sun child is reborn.  • 25 <sup>th</sup> Christmas Day - Christian festival celebrates the first Christian martyr.
