## Subject matter and geographical area covered

South Tyneside Council has prepared a Draft Local Plan 2021-2039 for consultation. The document covers the administrative area of the Borough of South Tyneside. The Plan sets out the strategic spatial planning policy framework for South Tyneside and includes:

- the strategic challenges faced by the Borough
- sets out the spatial vision, strategic objectives, and spatial development strategy for the Borough
- identifies strategic site allocations and policies
- provides a suite of strategic and development management policies to be used to determine planning applications within the city area
- identifies implementation and delivery policies
- identifies a monitoring and implementation framework
- a policies map.

#### **Period for making Representations**

Representations of support or objection are invited on the Plan for a period of six weeks from Monday 20 June 2022. All representations must be submitted within this period and received by the Council by 11.59pm on 31 July 2022.

Please note that representations received after 11.59pm on Sunday 31 July 2022 will not be considered. Only representations received within this period, by deadline, have a statutory right to be considered by the Planning Inspector at examination.
